

Zeraim (seeds):

concerns the rules for prayers and blessings, primarily deals with the laws of agricultural produce and tithes of the Torah which apply in the Land of Israel, in both their religious and social aspects.

Mo'ed (festivals):

concerns the rules for Shabbos, festivals, fasts, Regalim etc.

Nashim (women):

concerns the rules for family laws, wedding and marriage, divorce, nazir

Nezikin (damages):

concerns the rules for civil matters, property law, ownership, penalties, neighbours, testimonies, Avot (ethics).

Kodashim (holy things):

deals largely with the services within the Temple in Jerusalem, its maintenance and design, the *korbanot*, or sacrificial offerings, *kosher slaughter* of animals for non-sacrificial purposes

Tohorot (purities):

This order deals with the clean/unclean distinction and family purity
