Shabbetai Zvi – The Beginning

- Born on August 1, 1626 (9 of Av) in Smyrna
- 1648 – First Wife and Divorce
- 1650 – Antinomian Behavior - – מתיר אסורים – Utters Shem Shamayim
- 1653 – Cherem and leaves Smyrna
- Thessaloniki – Married a Sefer Torah
- Constantinople – Fish as baby - Flagged and Imprisoned
- 1664 – Sara bat Meir

Shabbetai Zvi – The Movement I

- Natan HaAzati – 22 yr old Natan of Gaza
- Lurianic Kabbalah
- 1664 – Messianic Message
- 1665 – Shabbetai Zvi meeting
- Lost manuscript
- Cancellation of 9 Av
- Tikkunim
- Gaza

Shabbetai Zvi – The Movement II

- Amsterdam, Poland, Morocco - All the way to South America
- 1665 – Back to Smyrna and Marriage to Sara
- 1666 – Fifth Monarchy in London
- 1666 – The Year of Expectation: Smyrna, Amsterdam and Poland
- 1666 - Return to Constantinople and the Sultan Ahmet Pasha
- Imprisoned in Gallipoli
- November 1666 – Conversion to Islam
- 1680 – Death


Smyrna 1665

- R Chaim Benveniste – *Kneset Ha-Gedolah*




Amsterdam - Followers
