Introduction: When is the levonah placed on the mizbeiach?<sup>1</sup>

- Sotah 14b; Rambam מעשה הקרבנות יג:יב – Kemitzah; Likut levonah; Put levonah on kometz; Maktir both
- תוס' מנחות יד. והלבונה, רש"י מנחות יג: ליקוט – Kemitzah; Haktarah; Likut levonah; Haktaras levonah

Mishnah: Can pigul thoughts during הקטרת לבונה for consumption of the bread create pigul?

- R' Yosi – Pasul, not pigul, because it's מן המנחה אינה מן המנחה
- Chachamim - Pigul

Focus: What is the nature of haktarah of the levonah?

Case 1: Pigul thoughts during haktarah, regarding consumption of the bread

Case 2: Likut levonah by a zar

Mishnah: Pigul thoughts regarding half of a zevach

- Pigul thoughts for 1 of the 2 Shavuos loaves; Pigul thoughts for 1 of the לחם הפנים
- Machlokes: R' Yosi says 1 is pigul, Chachamim say all are pigul

Gemara: R' Yosi says half a korban can be independently pigul

- Reason 1: Logic – Compare to tumah
- Reason 2: Pasuk – ממנו ולא מחבירו – האוכלת ממנו עונה תשא
- (Reason 3 on 14b: The Torah differentiates between the two challos)

Braisa says that pigul happens only with a thought of a full זית from both loaves, combined

- Not like Rabbanan (A זית from either loaf affects both)
- Not like R' Yosi (The loaves are separate entities)
- It's Rebbe, that ½ of each is mitztaref.

In other words:

Zayis from both loaves combined	Zayis from one loaf	
Pigul for both	Nothing	ברייתא
Pigul for both	Pigul for both	רבנן
Nothing	Pigul for one	ר' יוסי
Pigul for both	-	רבי
