Mishnah: Vow of שור, עגל, איל, כבש = Animal with nesachim totalling a set value

- If he specifies a value, that's just the animal
- If he specifies a value and brings multiple animals reaching that value, לא יצא.
- If he specifies color or size, he must bring that color<sup>5</sup> and size
- If he specifies small and brings large – Tanna Kama – יצא; Rebbe – לא יצא

Gemara: Vows of animals

- "עולה" – Debate about "עולה" is not a מחלקת; it's a matter of your<sup>6</sup> location<sup>7</sup>
- "בסלע" – Lamb, unless he says he specified a species
- On "bakar olah", why not just bring a bull, which is bigger than a calf?

Gemara: Why are there 6 שופרות for נדבה?

- 1 - Chizkiyah – One for each בית אב, from which they took funds for עולות לקיץ המזבח, to maintain peace<sup>8</sup>
- 2 - R' Yochanan – All 6 are for donations, to have much space and prevent corrosion
- 3 - Zeiri – For נדבות for 6 different types of animals, since we may not just bring the biggest, per Rebbe
- Explanations 4-6 – See 108a
