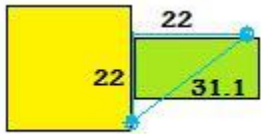

Three on the lower part of the southwest corner: Chatas Of, Hagashas Minchah, Shyarei Chatas Chitzon

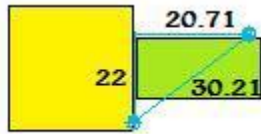
Three on the upper part of the southwest corner: Yayin, Mayim, Extra Olas Of
