Intra-Jewish Violence and the Consolidation of Jewish Power - The Altelena

"It was not an easy matter to send our comrades to an army whose officers had hated the underground, persecuted it, besmirched it, kidnapped its members and handed over its officers...The men who were about to take command of our members had been systematically trained to hate them."

Menachem Begin, The Revolt

Altelena

"There are not going to be two states and there are not going to be two armies. And MR. Begin will not do whatever he feels like. We must decided whether to hand over power to Begin or to tell him to cease his separatist activities. If he does not give in, we shall open fire...The entire future of the country is in the balance..."

David Ben-Gurion

Gen-Gurion and Begin Compromise

- 1. Etzel would enlist in IDF
- 2. Their arms would be turned over to the army
- 3. There would be no special Etzel brigades in the IDF
- 4. Etzel would cease operating as a distinct military unit in Israel

Begin Responds

"Do not raise a hand against a brother, not even today."

"There must not be a civil war with the enemy at our gates"

"Ben-Gurion is an Insane dictator...That fool, that idiot"

Ben-Gurion Responds

"...for no country can tolerate the importation of even a small number of weapons by private citizens or organizations without the government's permission!"

"The entire nation must eradicate the evil which exists among us"

"Stand close to the Temple, if it is built."

Begin Responds

"We had not yet buried our dead when Ben-Gurion claimed that the cannon he had commanded the fire at the Altelena was a holy weapon, worthy of a place in our future temple. Oh, the shame of it! No wonder people of high moral stature and impeccable repute chastised him for mouthing said sacrilege, reminding him that no holy Temple can ever arise so long as there are Jews with the blood of other Jews on their hands."



Begin Responds

"The most shameful event that has ever occurred in the history of our people he's about to take place this evening. At this bitter hour, we will recall our hallowed fathers, how our slaughtered mothers, and our babies who were led by the millions to the slaughter at the hands of the Satan who emerged from the very bottom of hell to annihilate the remnant of our people"

"Mr. Ben-Gurion has sent policeman here carrying grenades in teargas made in Germany, the same gases that choked our fathers; he has jails and concentration camps."










Diaspora Mentality?
