

The Orthodox Forum is convened annually by the Rabbi Isaac Elchanan Theological Seminary of Yeshiva University to consider major issues of concern to the Jewish community. Forum participants from throughout the world, including roshei yeshiva, rabbis, academicians in both Jewish and secular fields, Jewish educators, and Jewish communal professionals, gather in conference as a think tank to discuss and critique each other's original papers, examining different aspects of a central theme. The purpose of the Forum is to create and disseminate a new and vibrant Torah literature addressing the critical issues facing Jewry today. Sixteen books to grow out of these meetings have been published to date. Rabbi Robert S. Hirt serves as the overall series editor.
